





Frequently Asked Questions

When is the Cleanup Day? The Cleanup Day is scheduled for Saturday, Apr 22nd from 9am to 12 Noon.

Volunteers are invited to **[The School Yahd \(216 W Boylston St Suite 400, West Boylston, MA 01583\)](#)** beginning at 11:30 am for Lunch once you have completed their road or area cleanup. **You will receive free admission to School Yahd**

What happens if it rains? **The Cleanup Day will be held rain or shine.** **If necessary, you may cleanup at a time that is convenient to you, as noted below.

What does a Neighborhood Captain do? A street captain is asked to be the liaison for neighbors to contact regarding volunteering; providing the basic information needed, etc. The captain also is asked to coordinate with the Town by providing the names of volunteers and getting the necessary tee shirts and supplies from the Town to pass out to the team's volunteers.

What am I supposed to pick up in this event? We are asking our volunteers to pick up any litter or debris that can be easily picked up and placed in the provided trash bags. **Please do NOT pick up syringes or any sharp items.** If you find these items, please notify your group leader or the DPW telling them the location, and they will cleanup those items.

What if I see a tire or some other large item on the side of the road? **Please report all large items** to the DPW at 508-835-4820.

Where should I clean? Please feel free to clean along the road where you live. You can volunteer to be your street's group leader, or you can check to see who your group leader is by checking the map on the town website. Contact wbtownwidescleanup@gmail.com to volunteer or signup online <https://forms.gle/aCdy67SuS6KTT1gWA>

You can also volunteer to join groups to clear other roads/areas.

I'm busy that Saturday, what should I do? **** You can still help!** Feel free to pick up trash at a time that is convenient for you, but we ask that you drop off the filled garbage bags at DPW rather than just leaving them on the roadside. The dumpster will be at the DPW from approximately **Apr 18th through Apr 22nd**.

Can my kids clean too? Yes, but please keep them safely off busy roads. Consider cleaning parks and paths instead.

Will I need any special equipment? We will be providing bright event T-shirts, trash bags, safety gloves and pick sticks to any group that contacts us prior to the event.

Where can I get bags? The week before the event (**Apr 10th through Apr 21st**) you can pick up your bags, and supplies at the Town Hall - Monday through Friday from 8am – 3pm. **On the Cleanup Day itself**, supplies will be available at **[The School Yahd \(216 W Boylston St Suite 400, West Boylston, MA 01583\)](#)** any time after 8am.

Once the bags are full what should I do with them? You can place the full bags on the edge of the road where you cleaned, or you can bring them to the DPW to deposit in the supplied dumpster.
